For the 10th year in a row, the Summer School of Science in Visnjan (Croatia) will open its doors to high school students interested in taking their first steps in research. With the accent on teamwork and under the leadership of remarkable young scientists, the students get a chance to make their first contribution to science and technology.

In two summer camps held entirely in English, students both from Croatia and abroad will work on projects led by mentors from Croatia, Hungary, Slovenia, Switzerland, Great Britain and US. Projects cover current topics in molecular biology, experimental physics, chemistry and computer science. The program is expanded by workshops and evening lectures given by eminent scientists.

Summer School of Science offers a great opportunity for students with an ambition to work beyond the regular curriculum. In an open and informal atmosphere, they will have a chance to design their own career pathways, form new friendships with like-minded individuals, and share their enthusiasm for discovery and invention.
